⚠ Dos and Don'ts

- Handle with care
 - Materials of model are special compositions of soft resin, and carry a certain amount of weight.
- Wipe model with water or detergent
 Wipe stain or dirt with water or detergent.
 Do not use thinner or any liquid containing
- Do not place any printed material on surface of model
 - Prevent any other printed material from touching the surface of model.
- Do not use pen or ink on model

When used on model, pen or ink will be absorbed by material and can not be removed.

Store model in a cool, dry place

Prevent model from heat, humidity, and direct sunlight when storing after use. This is to prevent material change and damage.

 Do not store other printed material or item together with model

Long period of pressure on material could cause material to change shape.

Do not lay flat during storage

Make sure to store model with case in upright position.

- There could be discoloration in material Discoloration happens naturally when model is left unused for a certain amount of time. This will not affect the use of model.
- Do not pinch and pull only the protective sheet Do not pinch and pull the protective sheet on the manneguin surface.
- Do not touch the manikin with sharp objects. Long periods of pressure on material could cause material to change shape.
- Do not let model be in contact with other models during storage

Being in contact with other models could cause material to react and change in quality. Always store in case after use.

PLEASE READ:

Always follow the handling and storage instruction below, to keep the material with itselasticity and durability.

OBefore and after use, apply talcum powder to the surface of the manikin.

To keep good condition of the simulator, apply talcum powder to the palpation area.

OStore the manikin in the dedicated case for the simulator when not in use.

To prevent staining, deformation, or discoloration, store the manikin in the dedicated case for the simulator after use and when not in use.


O Maintain designated temperature, humidity and avoid direct sunlight for storage

Store the simulator below 60 degrees celcius.

Change the storage place immediately when the temperature indicator shows color circles as below.

How to open case Pre-practice procedures

1 How to open case

Open strage case and take manikin.

Hold the bottom of the model and remove it from the box.



Note: Do not lift manikin with the palpation lever. It may cause malfunction.



•Identification of manikins

Check the bottom of the manikin for a sticker indicating the type.


2 Pre-practice procedures

●To facilitate palpation, apply the supplied talcum powder to the palpation site on the manikin.





If friction is felt at the palpation site, apply additional talcum pouder to the surface of the manikin. Applying powder to the fingers is also effective.





Do not let ink from pens, newspapers, product manual or other sources contact the manikin. Ink marks on the manikin will be irremovable.
